Comments on accommodation , food, entry fees and other expenses	Accommodation was provided at Florio's cottage. Accommodation and food were good. During the entire event, drinks, coffee and tea were available at the starting point. Entry fee - 40 Euro (seniors); - 25 euros (juniors).

Final comments and evaluation of the contest	The competition met the standards for such an event. Newsletters were prepared on time. The general level of flying and competition was good. The team is experienced and the aircraft have been used for many years to organize competitions of this level in this area. The results and information about the schedule change were presented on time. - The control and distribution of the engines was done correctly, even so this point needs to be addressed. The engines were stored in a lockable case, were checked and certified by the manufacturer. Engines were issued during the selection of models before the start of the competition category. - Safety rules were observed.
